Dear Coach, Manager or Team official:

Congratulations on being accepted to the 2010 Canton Cup Tournament. This year's tournament is our 28th annual and being held on May 28, 29 and 30 (rain date May 31). The quality and diversity of teams selected to participate in this year's tournament is outstanding. You will be one of over 640 teams and we are sure your team will enjoy the challenge of the matches and the overall tournament experience.

Below you will find useful information about the tournament and steps you must take prior to the tournament as well as information that you will need at time of check-in, and other important items.

Mandatory on-line Tournament Roster

The Canton Cup requires each team to fill out and submit an on-line Tournament Roster prior to tournament check-in. This is **mandatory** and is essential for our usage during the tournament. Your Game Reports which you will receive at Check-in will already have your players names filled out. The Canton Cup prides itself as being ahead of most other tournaments with our internally developed scheduling and registration system. This is one way that we are able to accept over 600 teams without long lines at check-in and accommodating game schedules. On-line roster submission will be allowed up to Midnight, May 25th. If you do not comply, then at team check-in, you will be required to complete a roster via one of our remote laptops which will be available at a \$25.00 rental fee.

Medical Release Policy

You do not have to use the medical release format which we have on line. However you must present a properly executed medical release form at check-in for each player. Out of State and Canadian forms will be accepted at check-in. All out of state teams need to have player Medical Release forms notarized.





Risk Management Policy

As previously stated on our website, all coaches, managers and trainers involved in the games **must** have documentation of compliance relative to their own State/Province association relative to risk management. All Michigan teams must have risk management cards from MSYSA. Please contact www.msysa.net for more information. Please see notice in acceptance area for more details

Pass Cards

Every Select/Premier player must have a pass card. This lets us know that your player is a registered player and insured. The Canton Cup Tournament will accept club issued pass cards for recreation teams playing in a Select/Premier bracket – signed by registrar or club official. Pictures are still required.

Team Registration Schedule

Tournament Registration/check-in is on Friday, May 28th from 4:00-9:00 PM. A Coach or Representative must check-in before your first game at this time - please do not bring your entire team to registration unless you are playing Friday night. Registration is at our Tournament HQ located at Independence Park. If you have a 5:00 game on Friday, you may check-in between 3:00 – 4:00 pm (only teams with an early game may check-in at this time). Local teams may check in at Registration along with the Canton teams on Thursday, May 27th from 5:00 – 9:00 pm. Please email the tournament director for more information.

What is needed at Registration

Your Tournament Roster will already be printed by the Tournament Committee. You will need to submit a league roster (that can be kept by the tournament), guest player documentation (includes USYSA guest player form issued by your association – MSYSA, OYSAN, US CLUB, etc. and present player pass cards along with medical release forms. All Michigan teams are required to show Risk Management documentation for coaches, all out of state teams must show their state/provinces' equivalent. All out of state teams are required to submit permission to travel documentation.

Game Check in

Teams are required to check-in 30 minutes prior to each game. Player check-in before games will be at the check-in tents designated for your game field. To help speed up team check-in for your games, each player will be issued a Tyvek wristband at your first game check-in. This wristband is to be worn all weekend. The entire team needs to be in attendance for the first game check-in with wristband on. The tournament staff will go through the check in process and collect the pass cards. For subsequent division games, only a team representative needs to come to check-in to drop off pass cards. The referees will monitor that wristbands are in place for each player. Game sheets and referee payment tickets will be given to each team at check-in. For any championship or bonus game, the entire team will need to once again be present at the check-in tent. After any championship or bonus game, the pass cards will be picked up at the trophy tent.





Tournament Game Schedules

Schedules will be available on-line on or before Saturday, May 15th

No changes to the schedule can be made. We accepted over 640 teams and were able to accommodate most coaching conflicts and noted scheduling requests. Our scheduling program takes into account too many variables to change the schedules this close to tournament time. These variables include noted coaching conflicts, minimum rest periods between games and avoidance of two early morning games in a row on Saturday and Sunday. We hope you understand. The Canton Cup is one of the few, if not the only tournament of this size that can provide coaches a “no schedule conflict” guarantee for up to 3 teams.

T-Shirt Pre-orders

An online pre-tournament order form is available for the tournament t-shirt and sweatshirt (discounted prices). Please follow directions to submit your order. Your Tournament pre-ordered t-shirts can be picked up anytime during the tournament, but we prefer you do it following your Tournament check-in on Friday, May 28th at Independence Park. On May 29 or 30 they can be picked up from Tournament Headquarters at the Independence Park Pavilion. All orders are COD – payment due upon pickup. Pre-orders can be made online up to Wednesday, May 26th.

On-site sales will be available at Independence Park and Heritage Park (limited supply) over the tournament weekend.
